Tamar FM is MOBILE!!

Our local radio station recently unveiled their beautiful transmitting van. The unveiling was very well attended, with local MP's also present

The following up-date was sent to us by Kevin, one of the announcers at the radio

The Station has been using a borrowed camper van to cover Community Events for two years. Until now we could only do a local area broadcast via speakers at the event. These events include Doing Life Together, Cycling and Running events, Rotary / Lions fundraisers Christmas Parades and functions in Beaconsfield and Exeter. Due to the popularity of these visits the Station has been looking for their own van and 12 months ago purchased one. Over the past twelve months it has been panel beaten painted and sign written by Station volunteers and now will be able to visit any event or School and take it to air throughout the Valley whilst also providing on-site talk-back and music. The van will be used several times each month and would become an integral part of assisting the entire Tamar community. There has never been a free service like this available to Tamar Valley Community Groups. Tamar FM put to air approximately 213 Community Service Announcements each week. The unveiling to the Community by was officiated by Mayors from East and West Tamar Councils on the 16th November 2017 as a sign of the unit joining the entire Tamar region as one through Community Radio. This forms a major part of 7TFM's overall strategic plan. Now completed this van will be able to service the Tamar Area for many years without need for huge funds or replacement for many years.
